UNUSUAL OR SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

On January 14, 2016, the red light camera video at Lake Street and John F. Kennedy Drive was used to identify the suspect vehicle in a burglary that occurred in the 0-100 block of W. Lake Street. (AD16001034)

On January 28, 2016, the red light camera video at Lake Street and John F. Kennedy Drive was used to identify the suspect vehicle in a credit card fraud that occurred at several locations in Addison. (AD16001901)

On September 12, 2016, the red light camera video at Lake Street and John F. Kennedy Drive was used to identify the suspect vehicle in a hit and run at that intersection.

On September 21, 2016, the red light camera video at Lake Street and John F. Kennedy Drive was used to identify the suspect vehicle in two burglaries to motor vehicles that occurred in the 300 block of W. Lake Street. (AD16019967 and AD16019969)

2016 GOALS AND STATUS

1. Determine the feasibility of renewing the contract with RedSpeed Illinois, which expired on May 2, 2015. If it is found that the Village would like to extend that contract, take the necessary steps to renew it.
