## Traffic Corner-Back to School Safety



With school starting that means school buses are around the neighborhoods. Please drive cautiously and be aware of kids crossing streets and school buses with their equipment out.

**625 ILCS 5/11-1414 Approaching, overtaking, and passing school bus.** (a) The driver of a vehicle shall stop such vehicle before meeting or overtaking, from either direction, any school bus stopped at any location for the purpose of receiving or discharging pupils. Such stop is required before reaching the school bus when there is in operation on the school bus the visual signals as specified in Sections 12-803 and 12-805 of this code. The driver of the vehicle should not proceed until the school bus resumes motion or the driver of the vehicle is signaled by the school bus driver to proceed or the visual signals are no longer actuated.
