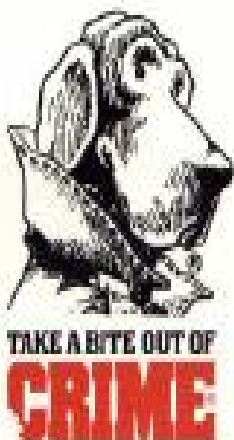
Business Watch Area

Community Emergency Response Team (C.E.R.T.)

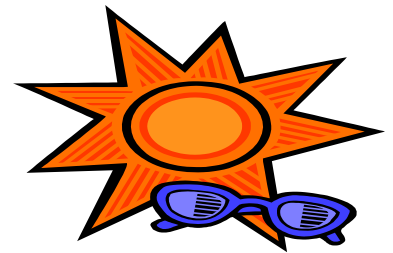
