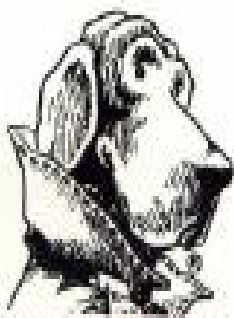
### 6th Ave Watch Area

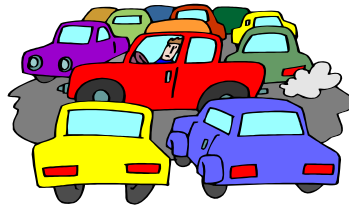

## Traffic Laws in



## School Zones

### Village Ordinance Sec. 11-84. Parking --Prohibited in Certain Specified Areas.

It shall be unlawful to park or permit any vehicle to stand in any of the following places at any time, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a policeman or traffic control device:

- (B) In a crosswalk.
- (H) Within fifteen feet (15') of a fire hydrant.
- (I) At any place where the standing of a vehicle would block the use of a driveway.
- (L) On any sidewalk or parkway. However, between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M. parking may be permitted on the driveway portion of the sidewalk and the driveway portion of the parkway.

### State of Illinois 625 ILCS 5/11-605 Special Speed Limit while passing schools

On a school day when school children are present and so close thereto that a potential hazard exists because of the close proximity of the motorized traffic, no person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour while passing a school zone or upon any public thoroughfare where children pass going to and from school.



### State of Illinois 625 ILCS 5/12-610.1 Wireless Telephones

(e) A person regardless of age, may not use a wireless telephone at any time, while operating a motor vehicle on a roadway in a school speed zone. This subsection (e) does not apply to (ii) a person using a wireless telephone for emergency purposes, including, but not limited to, law enforcement agency, health care provider, fire department, or other emergency services agency or entity.
