**Special Assignments:**

Officers assisted Investigations with several search warrants.

Officers worked in plainclothes patrolling the high crime areas. Several arrests were made for drug possession, criminal trespass and outstanding warrants.

Officers participated in Landlord/tenant meetings, College/Indian Trail Apartment management meetings, Park meetings and Neighborhood Watch meetings throughout the year.

Officers participated in numerous traffic details during the year in order to enforce traffic laws and provide a safe environment for the motoring public.

Officers assisted with ATAC/Detective's on ATAC investigations or call outs.

**Goals from 2016:**

**1. Increasing DUI arrests by 5% from 2015.**

Status: Through Schedule 13 the Night Shift has made 87 DUI arrests compared to 53 in 2015. This goal has been accomplished.

**2. Assign officer(s) monthly roll call training topics.**

Status: The Night Shift has conducted monthly Roll Call Training on the following topics, Miranda Warning/Custody, Photo-Lineups, Juvenile Officer Responsibilities, and Subpoena Requests, Drug Screening Kits, Social Services, Informants, and Social Media Harassment. This goal has been accomplished.

**3. To encourage and mentor shift members to attend and participate in events that build relationships with the community and promote a positive image of the police department.**

Status: Officers from both teams on a regular basis walked Rock N' Wheels and Italian Fest. Many of the Officers also work the College Blvd and Indian Trail Apartments detail. The purpose of these details is to provide police visibility, establish community partnerships with the



residents and apartment complex staff, and create a safe living environment. Officers from both teams worked the Police Officer Candidate Power Test, Provided Safety Presentations at local Day Care facilities, and volunteered for “Shop with a Hero”. This goal has been accomplished.

**4. To continue to cross train with specialty units, such as Detectives, and Crime Prevention.**

Status: Many of the Night Shift Officers have worked closely with Detectives by cultivating informants and working joint investigations. Many of the Officers have also worked closely with the traffic unit during the enforcement grants. They also assisted with the “Back to School” traffic detail. Officer also assisted the Detective Division with Sex Offender Verifications. Officer Fuentes also completed a temporary duty assignment with DuMeg in October. This goal has been accomplished.

**5. To have officers complete school walk-throughs of each school building at least one time throughout the year.**

Status: All of the Officers completed their school walk throughs for 2016. This goal has been accomplished.

**6. To have Officers conduct regular bar checks to ensure that bar owners are in compliance with all state laws and village ordinances.**

Status: As of schedule 13 Night Shift Officers have completed 2797 Bar/Premise checks. Officers also completed Liquor Establishment Inspections to insure establishments are in compliance with all stated laws and village ordinances. This goal has been accomplished.

**Goals for 2017:**

1. Increase DUI arrests by 5% from 2016
2. Conduct 3 enforcement sweeps (Warrant Sweep, Parole Compliance, Saturation Patrol)
3. Schedule 5 in-house training sessions for Officers (K9 searches, Debriefing Informants, Children’s Center Cases, Gang Trends, Hospital DUI arrests)
4. Increase parking tickets issued by 5%.
5. Initiate 6 pro-active investigations
