With the introduction of a new web-based version of the RedCheck violation reviewing software, officers are now able to log in to the program on any PC, iPad or tablet to review real-time video of the intersection for incidents under investigation. Officers also now have the ability to download the video for evidence. Throughout 2017, numerous suspect vehicles were identified using this new software package.

2017 GOALS AND STATUS
