## **Criminal Investigations Section**

The Criminal Investigations Section consists of one Detective Commander, a Detective Sergeant, eight Detectives, one of which is assigned to Addison Trail High School and one is assigned to Indian Trail Junior High School. In addition, we have one Sergeant assigned part-time as a task force officer with Immigration and Customs Enforcement and to the Gang Unit, two Gang Investigators, one DuMEG/Narcotics Agent, one full-time Crime Analyst/Investigative Aid and one part-time Investigative Aide.

The Criminal Investigations Section investigates all major crimes, some of which include homicide, robbery, criminal sexual assault, burglary and weapons offenses. The Criminal Investigation Section also investigates all types of organized crime, which includes street gangs. Internal investigations are also conducted by the Criminal Investigation Section.

The Criminal Investigations Section continues to maintain good working relationships with numerous federal and local agencies. They were involved in many long-term manpower intensive investigations. The Criminal Investigations Section personnel investigated a total of 772 new cases this year, with 78 carried over from last year, for a total of 850 cases. A total of 698 of those were cleared, 246 with arrests. Following is a summary of the caseload handled by the Criminal Investigations/Youth Division/Tactical Unit during the year:

## Intelligence

In 2016, the Gang Tactical Unit attended monthly gang intelligence meetings at the DuPage County Sheriff's Office and monthly narcotics meetings hosted by DuMEG. The meetings are designed for surrounding agencies to exchange information about gang and narcotics activity in their jurisdictions. Detective Glomb and Biles also attended the Illinois Homicide Investigators Conference hosted in DuPage County.

The Gang Tactical Unit also assisted several other agencies, such as the Elmhurst Police Department, Villa Park Police Department, Glendale Heights Police Department, Wood Dale Police Department, Bensenville Police Department, DuPage County Sheriff's Office, NIPAS-EST, DEA, ICE, and DuMEG/Illinois State Police with investigations throughout the area.

The Gang Tactical Unit also assisted the Detectives, Patrol Division and Crime Free Multi-Housing Unit of the Addison Police Department with numerous investigations.
