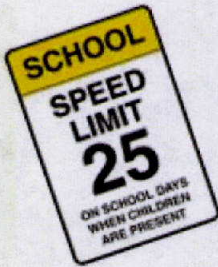


Parents & Teachers Can Make a Difference Too!

- Do Not Block Traffic By Stopping in the Middle of the Street to Load or Unload Students
- Obey All Curb Markings
- Do Not Stop Across the Street from the School—This Encourages Children to Run Across the Street Through Traffic

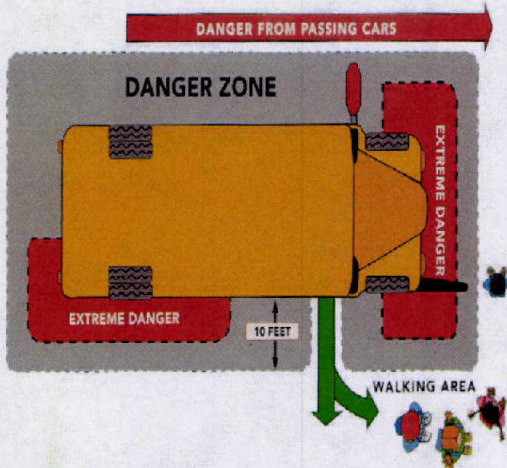

Tips for Traveling Back & Forth to School

Bus Safety



- Wait for the bus at the bus stop
- Stand back from the curb
- Wait for the bus to stop before approaching
- Don't move around on the bus
- Listen to the bus driver
- If there are seat belts -Wear them
- When exiting the bus: Take 5 giant steps out the bus door & out of the danger zone
- Never go back for anything you left on the bus
- Never bend down near the bus

Car Safety



- You must wear your seatbelt & be secure in an age appropriate safety seat
- All children under 13 should ride in the rear seat of a vehicle
- If you must sit a child under 13 in the front-move the seat as far back as possible & place the child in a booster seat to ensure the seatbelt fits properly
- Don't talk or text on your cell phone

Walking

- If your child is young or walking to a new school, walk them for the first few weeks.
- Wear bright colors so drivers can see you
- Use crosswalks
- Look left, right, and left again before crossing the street
